❖ Strategic objectives:

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT- through promotion of income-generating end-use applications of renewable energy sources, ensuring sustainable natural resource management, reducing greenhouse gas emissions through enhancing sustainable public transport management as well as educating and involving diverse national and local stakeholders in addressing environmental, energy and climate change issues within the country.

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Results achieved so far:

ENERGY:

- Adopted and Approved New Law on Energy-Efficiency and Energy-Saving, where establishment of the National Trust Fund envisaged;
- Piloted and demonstrated best practices on Integrated Rural Development (PPA, tariff calculation methodology, and O&M developed and piloted) on the basis of small Hydro Power Station in Burunov Jamoat, Vahdat district;

WATER:

- Policy dialogue platforms established and supported – IMCC for drinking water (MoLRWR), Water & Energy Council (GoT), National Policy Dialogue on IWRM (MoLRWR);
- Transboundary water cooperation mechanisms developed and supported between Tajikistan and Kyrgyzstan (consolidated cross-border water management reviews, mechanisms for information sharing);
- Legal and policy improvements introduced to promote IWRM, full-cost recovery tariff policies, good governance principles and water integrity, institutional reform, evidence-based water sector reform, construction permits for drinking water sector, consumer rights protection. Drinking water law adopted and changes to Water Code proposed.
- Water infrastructure developed/improved in target areas to promote effective implementation of IWRM based reform;
- Support to conduction of International High Level Conference on Water Cooperation successfully held in Dushanbe on 20-22 August 2013;

Environment:

- Adopted and Approved Forest Code, Law on Pasture, Law on Protected Areas (FS Tools and Management Plans);
- Developed Integrated Financing Strategy for SLM;
- Developed methodology for Climate Risk Management Strategy;
- Developed Environmental Education State Programme for 2013-2018;
- Initiated development of HCFC Phase-out national strategy;
- Improved Enabling Activities on Rio Conventions;
- Piloted and implemented above 40 community-development projects through UNDP-GEF SGP.



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Strategic plans for future:

Energy: Continued policy dialogue, renewing access to renewable energy sources, promoting technology transfer and small hydropower development by replication and scale-out of the Integrated Rural Development (IRD) approach, and building the local capacities;

Water: Continued policy dialogue and fostering legal reforms, promoting river basin Integrated Water Resource Management (IWRM) approach, improving access to safe drinking water & sanitation, building the local capacity and enhancing human rights and access to water resources, and contributing the fair management of International Waters/ Conflict Mitigation at border areas;

Environment: Contributing to the market transformation towards low emission economies – including climate change mitigation projects; and (b) capacity development for climate resilient communities, economies and ecosystems – including ecosystem, natural resources and climate change adaptation projects.

Cross-cutting: Gender Mainstreaming approach in all projects. DRR Certification and Environmental Impact Assessment and Expertise, as well as Poverty Reduction and achieving MDGs.
